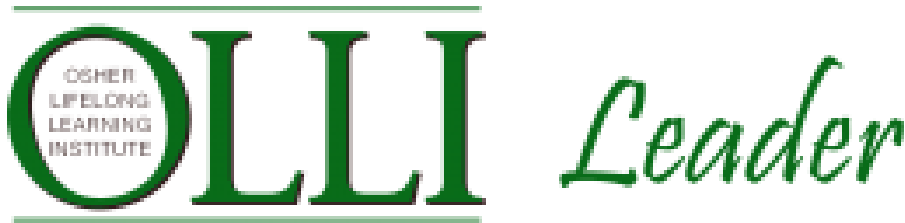


Committees
